The Flu Jab, it's not just about you!

Those who catch the flu pass it on to an average of two people putting those most vulnerable at an increased risk including those with long-term health conditions and pregnant



We have flu clinic sessions available during the next few weeks so please make an appointment.

You are eligible If you are:

- over 65 years of age;
- Over 18 years of age and have a long term condition such as respiratory and heart conditions
- Similarly children aged six months to two years at risk of flu
- If you are pregnant
- or, if you are an informal carer for someone
- There is also a new criteria this year, patients who are morbidly obese (BMI over 40)

If you are unsure, please contact the Reception. We are sending out invitations to those patients who we have identified as being eligible—but if you feel that you qualify for a flu vaccination, please contact the surgery please don't wait for your invite.

Don't forget that you can get a free flu jab at many of our local pharmacies if you fit the criteria

GP Care Wakefield

GP Care Wakefield is an extended out of hours service owned by all Wakefield GP Practices to cover the entire population of the Wakefield district.

It operates from 6pm-10pm Monday to Friday and 9am-3pm Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Telephones will be automatically diverted during operating hours. Outside of these times please telephone 111 or ring back during normal surgery hours if your need is not urgent.

Following triage of your problem, if deemed appropriate the service will offer you a GP appointment at Trinity Medical Centre or Pontefract General Infirmary.

There needs to be shared consent in place for the service to be able to provide safe care therefore please ensure you give explicit record sharing consent when accepting an appointment with the service. Patients who prefer not to give shared consent cannot access this service.

The service is not available for routine matters such as repeat prescriptions.

Routine care by HCA (Health Care Assistant)/Nurse

In addition to the above during 6pm-8pm Monday to Friday and 9am-1pm Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays patients can be seen for routine annual reviews of Heart Disease, Diabetes, COPD, Asthma and Stroke but only if you are well controlled and your condition is stable. Other routine nurse care includes:

- Blood tests
- Routine ECG (not chest pain)
- Spirometry
- Review of contraception pill
- Repeat depo injection
- Smears
- B12 injection
- Removal of sutures and clips

On-Line services

Patients are able to pre-book appointments online at the surgery using our On-Line Access service. This service has been available for some time but only 29% of our patients have registered for the service.

In order to use our on-line services, patients need to register for access. A username and password will be generated by our reception staff—pick up an information leaflet and registration form from Reception.
